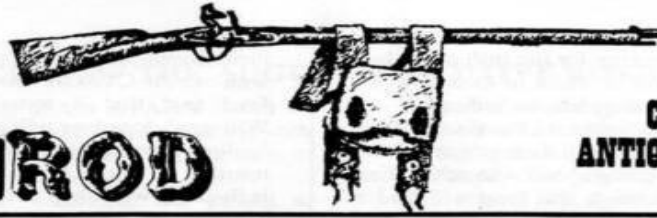

CTAGA Board Minutes - September 12, 2024

Present: Tim Pinkerton, Jim Dvorak, Bill Allman, Steve Kinser, Cindy Pinkerton, Dwayne McKinney

Absent: Joe Base, Wyman Warren

Guest: Scott Piper- his Green Card member, **Sam Othman**, needs another month before being voted in due to being out of town for the meeting. **Steve Kinser** also asked that both his Green Card members, **Sage Greenemeyer** and **Chris Hepner**, be granted an extension until November due to not being able to complete all shoots. Board voted and was approved unanimously all extensions.

Budget Proposals: Budgets for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 were submitted by **Bill Allman**, Range Officer; **Wyman Warren**, treasurer; **Joe Base**, Gun Show Chairman; **Cindy Pinkerton**, Secretary; **Steve Kinser**, Program Chairman; **Dwayne McKinney**, Vice President; **Jim Dvorak**, Program Chairman. All expenditures were reviewed and discussed. All budgets were approved unanimously. Budgets will be presented at the Member's meeting for final approval.

From Joe Base: The new Contract with Park City Arena is ready to be signed at the Gun Show next month; no price change for 2025 and an increase for the other two years of \$1,000.

-For this October Gun show most of the tables are filled and he has more vendors to contact.

-**Joe** has spoken with vendors from other shows and they do not see any changes in procedures for gun sales.

Bill Allman: If the budget is approved, he will have the gravel for the roads spread in November. The same company that has done it in the past, has the best bid on this project.

-The Fire inspection has been completed and all approved.

-CAS work party is scheduled for Friday before the Match.

-Dawg (from Chapman) has 10 24X24 mild steel targets for sale. After discussion, it was voted and approved to buy them to augment the targets that we currently have. **Bill** will pick them up.

-Ronde- will have the targets painted and grass mowed.

-Muzzle Loading monthly match- still looking for a member to run the match.

-Women On Target- will order another Port A Pot.

Dwayne McKinney: Has attempted to contact all members who have not paid this year's dues, most will be paying by check or the Website. Two members have moved and two do not want to renew their memberships. He will continue to monitor and talk with people

Cindy Pinkerton: Continue to send cards to those who have paid dues. We have more people requesting the Ramrod be mailed to them this year, the total is 7 now.

Steve Kinser: Lamar has been paid and some billboards will be put up early. They should be taken down after the Gun Show due to needing the space for political ads. The TV and Radio spots have also been paid and will be in place soon.

Jim Dvorak: September program is **Doug Bryant**, "Making Black Powder". October's program is **Mike Carson**, describing the Creedmoor Match Shoot history. November's program will be the Range Safety talk by **Bill Allman**. **Wes Lumry** would like two consecutive months to talk about Mountain Man.

Program note: *Doug Bryant's talk was pushed back to allow Phil Journey to provide an update on NRA and lawsuit.*

Budget for Fiscal year 2024-2025 was presented by Tim Pinkerton, with comparison to last year. After discussion, Jim Fry motioned and Wes Lumry seconded to approve the budget as presented. Unanimous approval by the members.

Joe Base (as reported by Tim Pinkerton): The October Gun Show is progressing, most tables are filled and the High School students are set to help with set-up and tear down. Joe has a contract with Park City Arena and plans to sign a new contract to keep the show there for the next two to three years. He said there is a small increase in our costs with the new contract, starting in 2026.

-Dues continue to come in and we are almost completed.

Jim Dvorak: Tonight's program is Phil Journey, talking about the lawsuit and the NRA and the board elections. Next month's program will be Mike Carson, discussing the history of the Creedmoor Match.

Dwayne McKinney: September 30th is the last day to renew your membership for this year.
