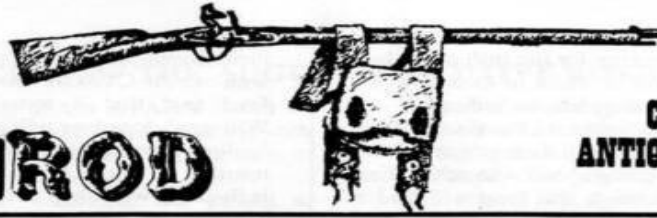

Joe Base (as reported by Time Pinkerton)- The October Gun Show is progressing. Joe is speaking with Park City Arena and plans to sign a new contract to keep the show there for the next three years. He does not anticipate an increase in our costs with the new contract. Changing venues would have too many obstacles, including an increase in labor needs on our part.

Bill Allman- There is going to be mowing and weed eating this week at the Range. Please contact Bill if you are able to come and help.

-Thanks to Jim Fry and Sam Othman for replacing the 200 yard targets that had blown down in the recent storms.

-I am canceling the work party that is scheduled for August 24th due to scheduling conflicts and the work that was planned has been completed.

Jim Dvorak- Tonight's program is by Dale Nice, talking about Hog Hunting.

-Next month Bill Allman will present the yearly Range Safety presentation.

Cindy Pinkerton- The website code will not change until October 1st, due to members needing to be able to use it to renew their dues.

-Dues are still coming in but most are paid. Members have been contacted if they have not paid as of this Tuesday.

Wyman Warren- All bills are paid and accounts are up-to-date.

-Member Jerry Shoemaker is ill at this time with spine issues and seeking treatment in Texas again.

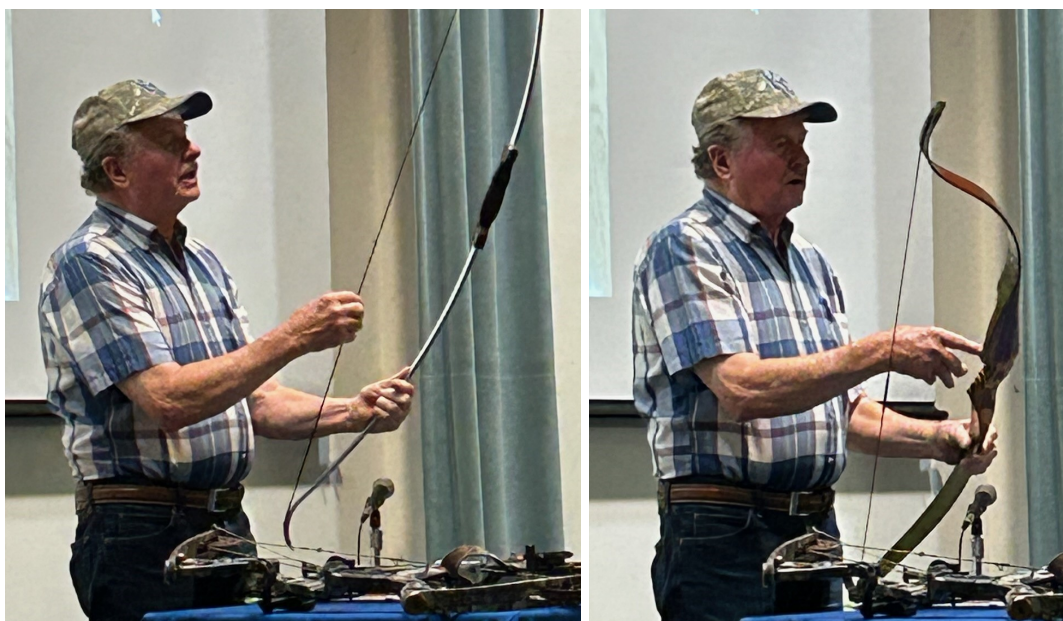

The August CAS match was attempted, but called off due to weather.

New long range category for Fall 2-Day CAS

Attention Cowboy Action shooters that plan to shoot in long-range rifle side matches.

Our upcoming "Gunfight along the Chisolm Trail" on September 14/15 will include a new long range rifle category that we are calling Frontier.22 Rifle. Rifles used must be any pre-1900 designed lever action, pump action, or single shot.22 rimfire rifle, with exposed hammer -.22 magnum will not be allowed. We will be shooting these at 185 yards from crossed sticks, same as our big bore rifles. The only difference is that the.22's will be shot at aluminum targets that will react by moving when hit and give off an audible sound from.22 strikes. Targets will be similar in size to those that we shoot in the big bore matches. We are still limiting our long-range side matches to shooting a maximum of three different rifle categories. If you prefer to shoot only one or two, that's OK. All side matches are shot on Saturday afternoon, following lunch.

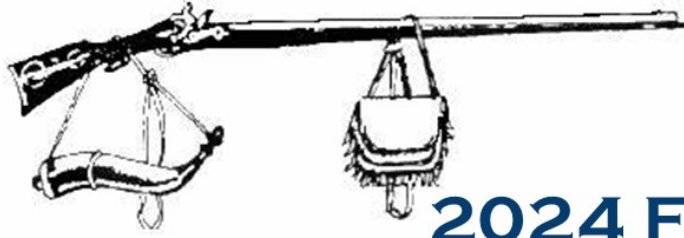
